BUHARI SACKS TONY JAJA, NCC BOARD CHAIRMAN

President Muhammadu Buhari has approved the removal of the Governing Board Chairman, Nigerian Copyrights Commission, Dr. Tony Clinton Jaja.

The removal was contained in a letter dated 15th October, 2020, signed by the Solicitor General of the Federation and Permanent Secretary, Federal Ministry of Justice, Dayo Apata, SAN and made available to the newsmen on 19th October, 2010, informing the President's approval for Jaja's removal with immediate effect.

The letter reads, "I have been directed to notify you of your removal as the Chairman, Governing Board of the Nigerian Copyright Commission by the President of Federal Republic of Nigeria, His Excellency, Muhammadu Buhari, GCFR, as vide letter Ref: 59312/V/230 of 28th September, 2020.

It continues, "Your removal is with immediate effect and you are, therefore expected to hand over the properties of the Commission in your possession to the Director General. "While wishing you success in your endeavours, please accept the assurances of the warm regards and best wishes of the Honorable Attorney General of the Federation and Minister of Justice.
